Many of the rooms have en-suite facilities and close to communal toilets and bathrooms.








COMMUNAL AREAS

ACTIVITIES



Stimulation through meaningful activity is important in promoting well-being. At Brightside we have a dedicated activity co-ordinator who will facilitate any activities you choose. Group activities are organised every week day and range from arts and crafts, sing-alongs, reminiscence sessions, board games, interactive games, quizzes, bingo etc. Brightside is also proud to be a part of the Care Home's Activities' Group in which we host and attend events held at other local care homes including pub style quizzes, parties etc.

We also invite the local community to celebrate key events with us including Christmas, Easter, St David's Day etc. Our local Church visits the home monthly and holds services for those wishing to be involved. This allows

our residents to mix with

individuals from the wider area of Cardiff in line with feeling like an active member of the community.





STAFF TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT

We have an experienced team of care staff, many of whom have been with us for over a decade. The benefits of a modest size means consistency in care staff allowing you to build meaningful relationships and in turn provide excellent care. The care team is lead by our Registered Manager who has over 25 years' experience in providing care to the elderly.

All members of our care team have achieved the Qualification and Credit Framework (QCF) award in Health and Social Care levels 2,3 or 5 depending on their position. All joiners are required to register and obtain this qualification.



LOCATION

Brightside Manor Care Home is situated on Newport Road, Rumney Hill. The Home is close to shops, restaurants, public house, post office, banks, leisure centre and churches, with a frequent bus service to and from the City Centre.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Are my friends and/or family welcome?

Brightside actively encourages family and friends to visit, escort you out and be a part of care planning. After all who knows you best other than your loved ones? We have an open visiting policy and accept visiting at any reasonable time. For practical and security reasons we encourage visiting from 10.30- 19.30, however visiting



outside of these times can be arranged with prior notice.

Are there set times for me to get up/ bath/ have my meals?

Brightside does not have rigid set times as we aim to achieve a relaxed atmosphere where resident choice is at the heart of the care we deliver. This mean you are free to plan your day as you please and staff will do their utmost to suit you preferences.

Can I decorate my room?

We encourage you to make your room as homely as possible, this includes bringing your own furniture, soft furnishings, paintings and photographs etc. We can decorate the room to your taste should you wish.

What are the meals like?

Brightside has an in-house cook seven days a week. We have a varied menu created by our nutritionist which aims to be both delicious and healthy. The cook visits every resident with a choice of the days meal,

residents are also able to make a special request should they fancy something different. Brightside provides home cooked, traditional British meals as well as catering to different cultures. Residents are not limited to meal times and can request a snack/ drink 24 hours/ day.

I need them."





FIND US FROM THE CITY CENTRE

📥 From Cardiff City Centre follow A4161 Newport Road (sign posted M4, Newport) leaving the city towards Newport until you reach the roundabout under a flyover. Carry on straight across the roundabout (taking second exit on B4487 – towards Rumney/Llanrumney) and follow Newport Road up Rumney Hill. Vehicular access to Brightside Manor is gained via Castle Rise, which is the third turning on the left.



Coming from the City Centre on any Llanrumney or Newport bound bus, alight at the first stop on Newport Road at the foot of Rumney Hill and walk up towards the traffic light about 100 meters. Pedestrian access gate is on Newport Road.
